PowerPoint

Office 365

- Available for personal computers via GWU IT

Panopto

When using Panopto, there are 3 options for recording.

- 1. Panopto App This is the preferred method. This method involves logging into Panopto with your NetID and password, and using the installed Panopto App. This method has the most flexibility, and allows you to edit in the same app after you have recorded.
 - a. Note: the Panopto app can be found in Software Center (PC) or Self Service (Mac) on GW-managed computers.
- 2. Panopto Capture This method is for when you are unable to install the Panopto App, but know your NetID and password. In this option, you will be able to record directly into the folder you want, and will not have to transfer the file to someone else to load into Panopto.
- 3. Panopto.it This option is for those who do not know their NetID and password. It will record and then you will be able to download your video to your computer, and will need to upload or send it to be posted for others to access.
